COLLECT BOX TOPS, COKE GIVE CODES & TYSON LABELS!



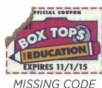

Collect and clip box tops and send them to school with your child. When clipping your box tops, please be sure to clip outside the dotted line. Box Tops missing dates and/or codes, or expired Box Tops cannot be submitted. Last fall over 200 Box Tops fell into one of these categories.
